Dear fraternity of the Central University of Gujarat,

Greetings on the International Human Rights Day.

We, in our country are the most fortunate to enjoy the best of Human Rights anywhere in the world, be it Right to Education, Right to Information, Freedom of Speech, Equality of Mankind, irrespective of the heterogeneous society which we live in. The freedom of expression, life, liberty, access to equal opportunity are the biggest advantages to every citizen in this country guaranteed by the Constitution and protected by the State and Government. At the Central University of Gujarat, we believe in the ethos of our national aspirations towards the above in letter and spirit.

As you are aware, the Central University of Gujarat in a short span of seven years has proved to be an Institution with promise to achieve greater heights in the coming years and decades. It is to the credit of its students, faculty and non-teaching staff that right in its seventh year, the University could achieve the 60th position under the NIRF, not to mention its 2nd place among the Universities of Gujarat and among the new Central Universities in the country. On this day of International Human Rights, I would like to advise the fraternity of CUG, the students, the faculty and the non -teaching employees who are enthusiastically involved academically and committed to the growth, development fame and fair name of the institution, not to fall prey to this malicious and mischievous propaganda programmed and executed by anti- institutional elements and not to despair and get disheartened, but to continue to do the good work in which they are involved for the further academic advances, name and fame of the Institution.

As you know, the University has always encouraged and welcomed open dialogue, suggestions and opinions from one and all and it shall continue to do so in future with your involvement and cooperation. Let us safe guard the future of our University and not allow anyone to vitiate the peaceful atmosphere of the Central University of Gujarat.
