National Commission for Women has notified to conduct Nationwide Competition to comply with the National Commission for women mandate.

The National Commission for women is an apex body established under Act of Parliament. The commission is mandated to study and monitor all matters relating to constitutional and legal safeguards provided for women; to review the existing legislations and suggest amendments, wherever necessary; look into complaints and take suo moto notice of cases involving deprivation of the rights of women in order to provide support, legal or otherwise; and monitor proper implementations of all legislations enacted to the rights of enable them to achieve equality in all spheres of life and equal participation in National Development.

The National Commission for women has, with a view to disseminate information on *Constitutional and Legal rights/ entitlements, ect., of women* decided to conduct the second Nationwide Competition for students of Colleges and Universities to assess and enhance awareness about legal rights of women.

Syllabus: Provisions of the Constitution and laws relating to women's rights and empowerment. The competition may, include topics relating to the following laws:

- (i) Constitution of India mainly, the Preamble, Fundamental Rights, Directive Principles of State Policy, Fundamental Duties, including Article 33 and Article 226 thereof.
- (ii) National Commission for Women Act, 1990 (20 of 1990)
- (iii) Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961
- (iv) Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005
- (v) The Sexual Harassment of Women at Work place (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act) Act, 2013
- (vi) The Criminal Law Amendment Act, 2013
- (vii) The Maternity Benefit Act, 1961
- (viii) The Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971 (34 of 1971)
- (ix) The Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956
- (x) The Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act, 1994
- (xi) The Minimum Wages Act, 1948
- (xii) SC and the ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015
- (xiii) The Scheduled Tribes and other traditional forest dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2008
- (xiv) Major International conventions relating to elimination of discrimination and violence against women

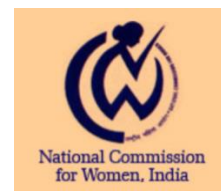
