The Candidate fulfilling **No Academic Arrear Guidelines** must fulfil the following guidelines:

Further, the candidate should not have any type of academic overdue or debt beyond the prescribed time/semester for the particular course he/she is pursuing for. Therefore, he/she must have neither taken a zero- semester nor an extension beyond the normal duration (of the particular course he/she is pursuing for) during/for the last one year/ last two semesters from the date of notification for election whichever is applicable. Moreover, he/she must not have taken any extension/repetition beyond the prescribed credit: time limitation given in the Academic Ordinances of CUG concerning the same.

Further, counting of the above guidelines therefore, shall not be taken into consideration in the case of the "integrated courses/degrees, for which individual degrees provided by university for both of the courses/degree or the individual degree, which has already been opted by the

- III. The Students Identity Card of the previous semester given to the Individual students duly signed by the competent authority at CUG along with any one of the following given as
  - a. The Student's Copy of the Registration folio of the current semester given to the individual students duly signed by the competent authority at CUG, or,
  - b. The fees receipts (admission/readmission/hostel fees) of the current semester given to the Individual students duly signed by the competent authority at CUG.

# **Annexure F**

# Code of Conduct to be strictly followed by the Candidates and his/her associates:

- I. Candidate has to give all necessary official information without any distortion of facts and figures to the assigned competent authorities during the time of election so required.
- II. Candidates shall refrain from criticism of all aspects of private life, not connected with the public activities of the other candidates or supporters of such other candidates.
- III. Criticism of other candidates or their supporters based on unverified allegations or distortions shall be avoided.
- IV. Criticism of other candidates, only during the Official Debates shall be confined to their policies and programs, past record and work.
- V. No candidate shall be permitted to make use of printed posters, printed pamphlets, or any other printed material for the purpose of canvassing.
- VI. No candidates shall be permitted to carry out processions or public meetings or in any canvas or distribute propaganda outside the University campus.
- VII. Neither the candidate nor his/her supporters shall deface or cause any destruction to any property of the University campus, for any purpose whatsoever, without the prior written permission of the University authorities. All candidates shall be held jointly and severally liable for any destruction/defacing of any University property.

# VIII. On the day of the polling, students involved with the candidates whatsoever purpose including their proposer and seconder and the candidates themselves:

- A. Shall co-operate with the officers on election duty to ensure peaceful and orderly polling and complete freedom to the voters to exercise their franchise without being subject to any annoyance or obstruction.
- B. Shall not serve or distribute any eatables, or other solid and liquid consumables, except water on polling day.
- C. Shall not hand out any propaganda/documents/papers inciting his/her support or with the intention of the wooing/intimidation of other contestant on the polling day.

No one, except the voters, shall enter the polling booths without a valid pass / letter of authority from the election committee or from the University authorities.

# **Annexure G**

### 1. Model Code of Conduct

- I. The Model Code of Conduct (MCC) is a set of norms to enforce all the stake holders of the university during the period of election. This is to ensure for conducting free and fair elections.
- II. The MCC binds all the stake-holders to respect and observe it in letter and spirit. (All the stake holders of the university include the students, the teachers, the working staffs and the other associates)
- III. This shall come to force from the date and time of the notification and will be valid till the period of declaration of the results.

# 2. Set of Norms (MCC) to be followed and imposed:

Set of Norms (MCC) to be followed and enforced during elections through proper notifications and further intimation to the Candidates as directed by the Election Committee:

- I. There shall be no activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students.
- II. There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing votes. Places of worship, within or outside the campus shall not be used for election propaganda.
- III. There cannot at any circumstance of indulging or abetting. All activities which are considered as "corrupt practices" and offences, such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters are prohibited.
- IV. Canvassing or the use of propaganda within 100 meters of polling stations, holding public meetings before the period of 24 hours of the poll and after twenty four hours from the ending hours of the poll, and the transport and conveyance of voters by the candidates during the polling time are strictly prohibited.

- V. The Candidates except casting his/her vote cannot enter the polling booth, and cannot campaign/woe the voters during the polling day.
- VI. Further, any short of campaigning after 10 PM by the Candidates especially, in the university hostels/hostels under the University supervision/control are strictly prohibited.
- VII. Pasting of Posters/banners/pamphlet/or wall painting/wall writing inside the campus of the university is strictly prohibited after the notification for election. This shall be strictly followed by any stakeholder of the university till the final result of the election is declared.
- VIII. During the prescribed and notified period for campaigning/canvassing the candidates may hold processions and /or public meetings provided that such processions and / or public meetings do not in any matter, disturb the classes and other academic and co-curricular activities of the University. Further, such procession / public meeting shall not be held without the prior written permission of the Election Committee.
  - IX. The use of loudspeakers, vehicles and animals for the purpose of canvassing shall be prohibited.
  - X. All candidates shall be jointly responsible for ensuring the cleaning up of the polling area within 48 hours of the conclusion of polling.
  - XI. Any contravention of any of the above recommendations may make the candidate liable to be stripped of his candidature or his elected post, as the case may be. The election commission may recommend the appropriate disciplinary authority to take necessary action against such a violator.
- XII. In addition to the above mentioned code of conduct, it is also recommended that certain provisions of the Indian penal code, 1860 (as given in the section 153A and chapter A "Offences Relating to Election" of the LCR), may also be made applicable to student elections for electing students representatives in ICC.

We the following members of the Election Committee (2019-20) hereby resolving this format as official Nomination form for Contesting Election of student representatives in ICC (2019-20) of Central University of Gujarat (CUG) which includes the Annexure A, B, C, D, E, F and G, all in combination in this nine-page document. We further resolve that the given guidelines/terms/conditions/declarations etc. in their totality shall also be followed as the rules/provisions/regulations on the basis of which the Election Committee shall take all the related decisions.

We also resolve that, information given by the candidates after signing this form, and submitted for the nomination can neither be given back nor be allowed to be amended by anyone including the candidates or their proposers or seconders.

Any discrepancy in information provided/ suppression of information, if so found by the Election Committee shall amount to the rejection of the Candidature.
