About University

The Central University of Gujarat was established through an Act of Parliament in the year 2009. It has jurisdiction over the entire state of Gujarat. It renders human services to a cause of higher education by catering to the academic, intellectual and professional needs of youths in the state of Gujarat and across the country. To this extent, it contributes its strength in generating and providing requisite human resources that India needs to emerge as a vibrant knowledge society.

About School of Education (SE)

The School of Education (SE) at the Central University of Gujarat will form the main backbone of integrated development of teachers. It is proposed

that school of education will have collaboration with national and international partners. SE will offer academic programmes in education as an area of knowledge and field of professional practice. The SE will prepare scholarly teachers to be engaged in educational discourses and knowledge generation. It will also provide avenues for professional development of teachers, teacher educators and other educational functionaries. The SE will provide programs of excellence in the pre-service such as Master of Education (M.Ed.) program, M.Phil. and Ph.D. in Education, it would prepare reflective teacher educators for performing various roles in schools, nonprofit organisations, government agencies and in-service education of prospective and practising teachers through teaching and learning, research, extension, consultancy, publication and community services. The University by setting up a School of Education proposes to strengthen the holistic vision for teacher education, keeping it intimately connected with school education. This would in turn support and enable professional development, research collaboration, School interventions, curricular resource development and state and national academic planning. The SE by starting M.Ed. program and at the same time takes a leading role in professional development of teachers and teacher educators.

Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India has approved a School of Education under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNTT) scheme in Central University of Gujarat.

Under the PMMMNTT, School of Education has taken two centres;

1. Centre for Policy Research in Education
2. Centre for Professional Development of Teacher Educators

At present under the Centre for Professional Development of Teacher Educators, the School of Education is organising 5 Days' Workshop on MOOCs through SWAYAM for Teachers and Teacher-educators.

About Workshop

A very promising technological and pedagogical model that has received a lot of attention during the last few years and adoption by Stanford, Harvard, Duke and almost 100 of the world's top ranking Universities to teach millions of learners is that of the MOOC. The MOOC is considered on the

one hand as a panacea for education and on the other as a defilement of the sanctity of the higher education tradition. The truth will probably lie somewhere in between and we must explore the potential of MOOCs to create a model of simultaneously teaching on-site and off-site learners, using synchronous and a-synchronous teacher learner interactions to deliver high quality learning to large numbers , maybe evolve a model for a classroom of 10,000 learners.

The workshop aims to give hands-on experiences to teaching faculty in using the SWAYAM/Moodle MOOC environments to develop course materials, blended learning and 100% online courses to engage students in learning. This workshop is a great starting point for effective teaching in the 21st century learning environment.

Objectives of the Workshop

- Exposure digital initiatives in India -higher education;
- To understand the process of planning, designing and implementing MOOCs through SWAYAM requirements;
- To give hands-on experiences in planning, designing, developing and implementing MOOCs through SWAYAM;
- To use SWAYAM/Moodle-Platform as an adjunct to face-to-face teaching and
 - to teach in a fully online or distance learning context and
 - to get a feel for how their courses could be enhanced using SWAYAM/Moodle platform;
- To sensitise online course instructional design methods & blended learning approach;
- To create better and active communication and collaboration with the students-
 - to design and manage learning assessment using Moodle and
 - to orient the OER based e-learning.

- The technology and pedagogy supporting MOOCs
- New skill sets needed for effective participation in MOOCs
- Adoption of e-resources for innovative teaching & learning practices
- Online course instructional design & best practices

- Introduction to Creative Commons Licenses(CCL)
- Open Educational Resources (OER) and MOOC
- Learning & Teaching an Online course using Moodle MOOC.

The faculty members working in various university education departments, autonomous colleges, affiliated colleges of the various universities are eligible to apply. Preferences will be given to those teachers who are working in universities or colleges under Sections 2(f) and 12 B of the UGC Act, 1956. The interested faculty to enhance their competency in MOOCs through SWAYAM can apply for the workshop.
