- Defining the Research Problem: Concept and need, Identification of Research problem, defining and delimiting Research problem.
- Inductive vs Deductive Method, Positivism, Behaviouralism, Hermeneutics, Falsification, Paradigm
- Research Questions and Hypothesis: Variables and their linkages, Research Ethics, Plagiarism, Literature Review,
- Characteristics of good Hypothesis. Research question and formulation of hypotheses-directional and non-directional hypotheses, Basis for hypotheses. Research design: Meaning, Need, Features of Good Design, Concepts, Types. Basic principles of Experimental Design, various methods of Research. Survey, Philosophical, Historical, Experimental, Causal Comparative, Genetic, Case Studies.
