Inaugural Session

The programme started at 11:00 am with the warm greeting from varinder Singh (Ph.D. Scholar). After the formal welcome of the participants, prayers was read by Roli Gupta and Chita (Ph.D. Scholar's). After prayers, an introductory speech was given by Dr. Shamim Ara Hussain (Convener of Awareness Programme & Assistant Professor, SOE CUG). Dr. Shamim Ara Hussain highlighted the objectives of the programme and the role of a teacher in Nation building. Dr. Shamim Ara introduced the honorable guest Prof. U. C. Vashishtha with main focus on the academic activities. Dr. Shamim Ara Hussain also introduced Prof. Sanjay Kumar Jha who is currently serving as Dean School of National Security Studies, Central University of Gujarat.

After the formal introduction, token of love and respect was presented to Prof. U. C. Vashishtha and Prof. Sanjay Kumar Jha by Prof. H. B. Patel (Project Coordinator, PMMMNMTT & Dean, School of Education, Central University of Gujarat). After presenting the token of love and respect, Prof. H. B. Patel addressed the gathering by introducing Prof. U. C. Vashishtha. Sir gave the brief idea of PMMMNMTT and the future events that will be carried out in School of Education in due course of time.



Inaugural Session

Main Session

Prof. U. C. Vashishtha started the lecture at around 11:40 am. Sir started the lecture with introducing the teacher education and said that in India there was not any institution of teacher education. Sir talked about a survey in which there was mainly three important ideas, one was that in every village of India, there was an organized system. The second idea was that there was educational institution in India and the last idea was that in every village, health facility was there. This all system broke into pieces during British period. Sir highlighted the importance of the book “The Land of Seven Revers” which gives a picture of the GDP growth in India. Sir

highlighted the role played by the University Education Commission, Mudaliar Education Commission and Indian Education Commission for the welfare of teachers. Sir said that in 1977, the new government in India also prepared the Draft of New Education Policy but the policy remained confined to papers only. He also gave introduction of DIETs as was laid down in National Policy of Education 1986. Sir highlighted the importance of Birla Ambani Report which has given significant recommendations in the field of teacher education but was not implemented properly. The report says that education is all about profit where any person can invest and get benefits.



Lecture by Prof. U. C. Vashishtha

In New Education Policy 2019 (Draft), it has been written that the education of the child will start as the child attains the age of three years. The period of graduation that has been proposed is four years. Every child will be taught Foundational Numeracy and Literacy till 2025. There will be integrated and flexible curriculum. Sir also said that vocational education will be a part of school education. New establishments of school complexes will be made under NEP-2019. There will be proper mechanism for teacher recruitment as well. Efforts will be made to establish multidisciplinary institutions. English language will be optional language. Sir said that India is one of the top bilingual country as was found by various researches. There will be some measures for the carrier development for teachers. Sir said the government is taking efforts to establish educational institutions in each and every village and for which necessary feedback is being received from the common people.
