Sub: Constitution of Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP) of School of Applied Material Sciences.

Ref.: Approval of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor dated 13.08.2021.

As per UGC (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations-2018, the Competent Authority has constituted the DAIP for the School of Applied Material Sciences with following members for a period of two years w.e.f. 13.08.2021.

Note: The tenure of the members in respect of points 'b' and 'c' shall be two years. The quorum for the meetings shall be 2 out of 3 members (including Chairman).

Term of Reference:

1. If any member of the academic community suspects with appropriate proof that a case of plagiarism has happened in any document, he or she

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shall report it to the Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP). Upon receipt of such a complaint or allegation the DAIP shall investigate the matter and submit its recommendations to the Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP) of the HEI.

2. The DAIP shall follow the principles of natural justice while deciding about the allegation of plagiarism against the student, faculty, researcher and staff.
3. The DAIP shall have the power to assess the level of plagiarism and recommend penalty(ies) accordingly. After investigation, the DAIP shall submit its report with the recommendation on penalties to be imposed to the IAIP within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of complaint / initiation of the proceedings.
4. If there is any complaint of plagiarism against any member of DAIP, then such member shall excuse himself / herself from the meeting(s) where his/her case is being discussed/investigated.
5. DAIP will certify the extent of plagiarism for M.Phil./Ph.D. thesis submitted in the Schools as per the Clause 8 of the UGC notification 2018.
