At the outset, the Registrar welcomed all the internal and external members of the Academic Council and requested the ICT team to recite audio of the Kulgeet.

In his introductory remarks, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor welcomed all the external and internal members of the Council and gave a detailed account of various activities undertaken by the University. He intimated the House that the University has made heartening progress since the last meeting of the Academic Council held on 27.09.2021. He then proceeded to recount a few of the major achievements of the university.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor informed the House that the University has implemented the mandate of NEP-2020 as directed by the UGC and MoEd from time to time. As a part of the implementation, the University has introduced a compulsory non-credit course in Holistic Education both at UG and PG levels as well as Multidisciplinary courses as minor electives. That apart, the university has registered on the portal managing Academic Bank of Credit and repurposed the syllabi of all UG and PG programs within the LOCF laid dawn by UGC. Further, the university has successfully implemented UGC Regulation on offering MOOCs through SWAYAM platform. He further informed the House that inspite of the pandemic, the University has followed the Academic Calender and has imparted education online, for sometimes in blended mode and now fully in offline mode. The University has successfully conducted examinations and declared results in time. The University has carried out recruitment in the meantime and appointed a few faculty members as well as processed the applications for CAS promotions. This year, the University is going to offer admission to Bachelor and Master programmes through test University has strengthened the Central conducted bv NTA. The Instrumentation Facilities by upgrading and repairing the scientific instruments. Patents have been filed by the faculty members. Two faculty members of the University viz. Prof. Dinesh Kumar and Dr. Kulhari have figured in the prestigious list of the "World Top 2% of Scientist" prepared by Stanford University, ScienceTech Strategies Inc., USA and Elsevier. That apart, Prof. Atanu Mohapatra bagged Atal Behari Vajpayee IPSA National Award. For the

first time in the history of CUG Dr. Shiju Sam Varughese has been awarded Fullbright Nehru Academic and Professional Excellence Fellowship recently. One of the students of the university has been awarded full travel grant to participate in the 47<sup>th</sup> National Organic Chemistry Symposium 2022 to be held at University of California, USA. The University Volleyball Team secured 1<sup>st</sup> position in Gandhinagar Volleyball Tournament and a student secured 1<sup>st</sup> rank in Disc Throw competition. Further, the Central University of Gujarat has been granted Dr. Ambedkar Centre for Excellence for which an MoU has been signed at BHU recently. The construction in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase of infrastructure projects of the permanent campus of the university has been started and going in full swing.

The Members congratulated the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and entire CUG fraternity for their committent to the institution which is visible from the achievements and progress made by the University. Then, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor took up the agenda of the meeting.
