Rules and Regulations for the Competitions under 'Sangeet Se Sadbhav— Music for Harmony'

PATRIOTIC/FOLK SONG (SOLO)

- 1. This is a solo event.
- 2. Performance should be a Patriotic/folk song.
- 3. Duration of performance is 3-5 minutes.
- 4. Accompaniment should be live one.
- 5. Maximum two live accompanists are allowed.
- 6. Judgement will be based on criteria of Taal, composition and presentation.
- 7. Decision of the panel of experts will be final.

PATRIOTIC/FOLK SONG (GROUP)

- 1. One group song will be presented by the team which will be either a Patriotic **or** a Folk Song.
- 2. Maximum number of singers in a group can be five (5). Maximum number of participants playing instruments (non-singers) shall be three (3). In addition, singers are also allowed to play instruments.
- 3. Only students are allowed in a team of participants (singers/non-singers playing instruments).
- 4. The Group song should be in any Indian regional language.
- 5. Maximum time allowed for the group song is 5-7 minutes, excluding setting time.
- 6. The setting time for a group song shall not exceed 5 minutes.
- 7. Judging of this item will be based on criteria quality of singing only and not on make-up, costumes, and actions of the team. The theme, Sruthi, Tal, Rhythm, Harmony etc. will be considered for the judgement.
- 9. The decision of the panel of experts will be final.

FOLK/TRADITIONAL DANCE (SOLO)

- 1. The Dance can be either traditional or a folk dance form from any part of the country.
- 2. Participants are responsible for wearing appropriate costumes and makeup.
- 3. Duration of the performance should not exceed 5 minutes.

- 4. Judgment will be based on the criteria of Rhythm, Formation, Expression, Costumes, Makeup, Sets, and over-all effect.
- 5. Decision of the panel of experts will be final.

FOLK/TRADITIONAL DANCE (GROUP)

- 1. Maximum number of participants in a group is ten (10).
- 2. The team may consist of all boys, all girls, or a mixture of both.
- 3. The number of accompanists permissible is five (5).
- 4. Duration of the dance should not be more than 07 minutes.
- 5. Judgment will be based on criteria of Rhythm, Formation, Expression, Costumes, Make- up, Sets, and Over-all effect.
- 6. Decision of the panel of experts will be final.

SKIT

- 1. Skit is a short play either satirical or humorous in nature. Vulgarity or bitter insinuation should be avoided. Only innocent satire or humour is expected.
- 2. Maximum 8 and minimum 4 participants will be allowed in this competition.
- 3. Participating team should submit **three** copies of the script.
- 4. Time allotted is 10 minutes.
- 5. Use of Make-up, drapery and background music is allowed.
- 6. The item will be judged basically on the criteria of Theme, work on acting, stage craft, total design, and general impression.
- 7. Medium shall be English/Hindi.
- 8. Costumes and make-up should be according to the themes and it is the responsibility of the participants.
- 9. Maximum **three** (3) student accompanists will be allowed for music.
- 10. The accompanists will not enter the stage.
- 11. The accompaniment can be either live or track.
- 12. The item will be judged on the criteria of quality of the play, theme, work on acting, stage craft, design and general, impression etc.
- 13. The decision of the panel of experts will be final.
