A Walk-in-Interview is held on **27/06/2023 at 12-00 PM** at School of Environment and Sustainable Development, Central University of Gujarat, Sector 30, Gandhinagar (Gujarat)-382030 for the post of Junior Research Fellow (JRF) with a stipend of Rs 31000/- + HRA per month in a SERB, New Delhi sponsored Research Project entitled “**Environmental monitoring of heavy metals using common road side plants in selected cities of Gujarat**”.

Essential Qualification: The candidate must have MSc Environmental Sciences/ Botany/ with at least 55% Marks or equivalent CGPA/DGPA and Selected through a process described through any one of the following:

- a. Scholars who are selected through National Eligibility Test – CSIR-UGC NET including Lectureship (Assistant Professor) and GATE
- b. The selection process through national level examination conducted by Central Government Departments and their agencies and institutions.
